Maths shows an improvement of a child up to expected, with one child going down for exceeding.</p> <p>Y3 - reading one child moved form below to expected, writing and spag have stayed the same and in maths one child has slipped from exceeding to expected.</p> <p>Y4 - reading two children have moved from below to expected and two from expected to exceeding. Writing, two children from expected have gone to exceeded. Maths has stayed the same.</p> <p>Y5 - reading, one child has moved from expected to exceeding. Writing is the same. Maths one child has moved from below to expected.</p> <p>Y6 - reading, three children have moved from below to expected. Writing two children have moved from below to expected. Maths, one child has dipped to below.</p> <p>Discussion was held about NfER and how the school uses the tests and teacher assessment information. Question asked about if school were</p>

		worried about anything. Discussion held regarding lack of parental support towards booster sessions etc. Also the influence of computer games etc on progress, attitude etc. as well as from parents if this issue is raised.
