#### **National Strikes**

You may be aware from media coverage that The National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action, which is scheduled to take place on the following three dates in our region: March 1st 2023; March 15th 2023; March 16th 2023.

The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the union and the government over school funding and teachers' pay. We can confirm that on this occasion, following a risk assessment and taking into account staff members wishes and union direction, that the school will remain open as normal on March 1st 2023 and we anticipate this to be the same for the other March dates but at this stage, we cannot confirm this. Staff in school have given this full and careful consideration. The school will not frustrate disruption caused by legitimate strike action. We will endeavour to give you as much notice as possible.

## **Grindleford Gallop Saturday 11th March**

Thank you to those who have already volunteered to bake for the Gallop. We need at least **1500 slices** for our hungry walkers and runners which is roughly **30-40 slices per family** at Grindleford school. You do not need to be a Great British Star Baker to supply us with cake! **Remember you can freeze your traybakes if you want to bake in advance**.



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Please can you divide your bakes into slices (roughly 4 x 7 cm), wrap them individually in clingfilm (we recognise this is not environmentally friendly but it's for food hygiene) and **drop them off at school on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March in the morning**. It would be helpful if each slice can be labelled as to the type of traybake /flapjack etc and if they are gluten free or vegan friendly.
