#### **School Information**

Please ensure that the yellow update forms are completed and returned to the office if not already submitted and you continue to tell us about any changes to medical needs for your children. #### **School Attendance**

Good attendance at school is critical to success in learning. This includes being on time for lessons in the morning as children who are 'rushed into school' or habitually the last to arrive can find this very unsettling. Please do try to be on time although we do understand, there are always 'those mornings' when things do go wrong. Your child will not be told off for being late so please do reassure them of this if needed. If you are struggling with arriving on time, please contact the school as support may be available.

The rules regarding term-time holidays have not changed and only in exceptional circumstances are these allowed. There is a form to complete if you need to request time off during term time and this is available from the office or on our website. Please note, 14 days' notice is required. From 08:40 - 08:55 children will be set morning work (appropriate to their age and stage of learning) by the class teacher. ### **School Meal Prices September 2023**

As previously communicated we have had notification that Derbyshire Catering Service has reluctantly made the difficult decision to increase the charge to schools for a paid school meal. This decision has been taken in the face of rising costs.

Therefore, from 1 September 2023 the cost of a school meal will be as follows:

• Paid Primary Meal - £3.25

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will continue to receive universal free school meals.

I would like to reassure you that Derbyshire Catering Service is committed to pricing meals to only cover costs, without making a profit (as required by legislation).

If you would like to make any changes to your child's school dinner commencing in September 2023 please could you advise the school office by email by the end of this term (Thursday 20th July 2023)

### **Young Voices - January 2024**

We are excited to share that we are registered to take part in the Young Voices concert in Sheffield on Thursday 8th February 2024. The children will get the opportunity to be part of the largest School Choir in the World. The children will spend the afternoon rehearsing and then perform in the evening. Parents / carers will have the opportunity to purchase tickets and enjoy the show. The children will be transported to the venue by coach with staff members but will need to be collected from the venue after the performance.
