School Updates

We are pleased to let you know that we have completed our recruitment exercise to appoint a Deputy Headteacher for school. This is a new post, which will be very important to help take the Federation forwards as they will deputise for Mrs Gemmell when she is not in school. The appointee is Mrs Anna Crease and she will be the substantive Class 3 teacher as well as taking on additional duties. Mrs Crease is a very experienced class teacher who has many years experience, including teaching mixed-age classes and upper Key Stage 2. She has also got significant skills with regard to subject leadership and has taught in both large and small schools

Due to teacher contracts, Mrs Crease will not join us until January 2024 but the children will be introduced to her in the few weeks before Christmas. This will allow us to provide a planned and smooth transition between teachers. In order to support Class 3, we have not announced this to the children yet as there is a long time between now and January 2024. They have a good relationship with Miss Grant and they are working very hard and we do not want to unsettle them.

Mrs Scott is currently on a phased return to work and we are looking forward to welcoming her back in the near future. When she returns, she will initially be on a reduced contract and will initially work in Class 1. She is currently spending time in class to support her return to teaching and getting to know Class 1 pupils.
